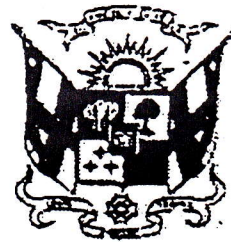

Dear Minister Vinedresser.

This letter has been drawn to set forth the Central African Republic's official and formal recognition of the government of the Dominion of Melchizedek, an Ecclesiastical Sovereignty.

Therefore, the Dominion of Melchizedek is hereby invited to establish a Diplomatic Mission in our Republic and will be granted all the consummate and traditional rights and privileges delineated in the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations.

Furthermore, business organizations organized under the laws of the Dominion of Melchizedek shall be encouraged to open representative facilities in our Republic to promote the development of international commerce.

Finally, any Real Estate purchased by the Dominion of Melchizedek from our Republic shall become and be treated as Sovereign Territory of the Dominion of Melchizedek.

We are encouraged and looking forward to the development of a mutually beneficial relationship between our two countries.
