



Treaty of Peace and Recognition

Preamble

In order to establish a permanent peace and friendship between the contracting parties, The Dominion of Melchizedek, an Ecclesiastical Sovereignty incorporating the Melchizedek Islands, Pacific Region, and that portion of Antarctica 90 degrees thru 150 degrees West previously unclaimed, now claimed by the Dominion of Melchizedek, and the Government of Republic of Burkina Faso agree to the following:

Article One:

The Government of the Dominion of Melchizedek acknowledges that the Republic of Burkina Faso to be a free community that has the right to exist unhindered.

Article Two:

The Government of The Republic of Burkina Faso acknowledges that the Dominion of Melchizedek to be a free community that has the right to exist unhindered.

Article Three:

Upon mutual ratification and implementation of this treaty, the contracting parties agree to directly discuss any issues of mutual concern via the most expedient communications available to the parties.

Article Four:

Each of the contracting parties agrees to acknowledge that the citizens of the other party has the right to travel in the other's domain.

Article Five:



Diplomatic relations are hereby established between the contracting parties

Article Six: Each party will allow the other party to obtain land and buildings, and have full sovereign rights over such acquired property.

In Conclusion, the contracting parties shall have mutual respect for a lasting peace between the parties and any and all situations shall be resolved diplomatically
